Cub Scout Resident Camp 2009 Planning Guide

DEPOSIT: A non-refundable deposit of \$25.00 per person, along with your completed reservation application is due by the **Initial Deposit & Registration Deadline**. The deposit applies to your total camp fee. After the Early Bird Registration deadline, the Full Fee will apply (\$10 more). Individual reservations and fees are accepted until the late registration deadline. After the late registration deadline no reservation will be accepted without Camp Director.

PARENT ORIENTATION MEETING: The orientation meeting for adults coming to camp will be held at 7:00 p.m. at the Longhorn Council's Waco and Hurst offices on Wednesday of the week before each camp session starts.

REQUIRED HEALTH FORMS: All adult and youth camper must have a completed Class 1 Personal Health and Medical form (does NOT require a doctor's exam). The Health Department requires immunization dates and parent signatures on health forms. **Do Not Mail your forms in-please take them with you to camp when you check-in.**

LEADERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: All units in camp MUST BE under the direct leadership of two adults at all times, one must be at least 21 years old and the other at least 18 years old. Adults may rotate with other parents or leaders; however, at least two qualified adults must remain in camp with the unit 24 hours daily while in camp. All adults in camp should be familiar with the BSA's youth protection policies.

Adults attending the Webelos Resident Camp at Camp Tahuaya will need to bring some additional information to meet Texas state camp requirements for 4-day camps, including a youth protection card. Check the Cub Scout Resident Camp page for details at www.longhorncouncil.org.

ACTIVITIES: You'll spend lots of time in the pool and fighting water battles. All Cub Scouts and parents are invited to bring water pistols, squirt bottles, Super Soaker type water guns, water balloons, or other water battle devices. Leaders and parents should keep the water toys, except during designated water battles.

WHAT'S INCLUDED: All tents, meals, eating utensils, program materials and equipment are provided by the camp for each camper. The camp does not provide cots or mattresses for the campers. Cots may be rented for \$5 per camp session.

WEBELOS CAMPS: The Webelos Resident Camp programs will focus on earning Webelos Activity Badges.

ACTIVITY BADGES: Aquanaut, Citizen, Outdoorsman, Readyman, and Forester. **BELT LOOPS:** Archery, BB

RULES TO HELP YOU PLAN:

1. Remember that we strongly suggest one adult per youth.
2. If a scout and an adult are sharing one tent, then the adult must be a parent or guardian of the boy. Adults sharing tents with youth is discouraged.
3. **NO ONE IS TO RIDE IN THE BACK OF A PICKUP.** You must have seatbelts for each person in any vehicle except buses.
4. The **MAXIMUM** speed in camp is about 10 miles per hour. If there are youth around then one must drive **NO** faster than walking pace (about 3 MPH).
5. Instructors on the BB and Archery range have a heavy responsibility for your child's safety. They can and will ask anyone who is not serious to leave the area. Please help them to keep the shooting ranges safe.
6. Please report all major accidents to the Camp office.
7. Bring a poncho, raincoat, or other rain gear with you. The show will go on rain or shine.
8. Remember that we are here for the boys and that we must let them have fun.
9. No Pets. No alcoholic beverages. No fireworks.
